



Welcome Prospective UNC Charlotte Hockey Player to the 2009-10 Season

The 49ers hockey team represents UNC Charlotte in the ACHA Division III and Blue Ridge Hockey Conference. The enclosed schedule consists of 26 games, opening on the road against UNC Chapel Hill, October 2 and Duke, October 3. The regular season consists of 8 road games, 12 home games at Extreme Ice Arena, two tournaments and season ending playoffs in February.

Membership Requirements

Prospective players must complete the following items to join the 49ers hockey team:

1. Enrollment Status at UNC Charlotte
 - a. Players must maintain a 2.0 GPA and complete 12 credit hours
2. Complete and Sign Eligibility Forms, Enclosed:
 - a. Code of Conduct with Student ID Number
 - b. ACHA Player Agreement
 - c. ACHA Player Consent to Release (Team form signed at tryout)
 - d. ACHA Fall Player Eligibility (Team form signed at tryout)
3. Attend Tryout, Tuesday, September 8, 9:50PM
4. Attend Team Meeting, Wednesday, September 9, 6PM
5. Furnish Member Dues
 - a. \$50 Tryout Fee, Due September 8
 - b. \$450 Assessment, Due September 9
 - c. \$200 2nd Assessment, Due November 1

Registration

Tryout registration will begin at 8:30PM in the lobby of Extreme Ice Center. The tryout fee of \$50 and eligibility forms will be collected by general manager, Alan Morgan at registration.

Tryout

Head coach Marc Chavaree will conduct the tryout, he'll be assisted by coaches Greg Hartley and Will Thompson. Players will be evaluated on skating, agility, shooting, hockey tactics and attitude. Be dressed and ready for full contact at 9:50PM, cages are required per NCAA guidelines. The final player selection will be announced at the team meeting on Wednesday, September 9.

Team Meeting

Coaches and staff will conduct a season overview meeting on campus Wednesday, September 9, 6-8PM. The first player assessment of \$450 is due at the team meeting. Your attendance is required.

Player Fee

In addition to the tryout fee, each player selected for the team roster will pay two assessments to the Treasurer, David Kennahan. The fee helps cover operating cost of \$25,000 including ice time, referees, leagues, insurance, uniforms and transportation. Costs are supplemented by University Club Sport allocations and donations.



Pre-Tryout Conditioning

The 49ers will host nine conditioning sessions on the dates below. Eight workouts will be held on campus at the intramural fields, behind the baseball stadium, from 6-7PM. On Sunday, August 30, the session will be at Extreme Ice 5-6PM; players will pay \$15.

Rules of Conduct



Participation in UNC Charlotte hockey is an privilege and not a right. This privilege is afforded to players in Good Standing, who comply with the Rules of Conduct. Failure to follow these Rules is subject to board action including disciplinary action up to and including dismissal from UNC Charlotte hockey activities.

1. Good sportsmanship is required; defined as acting with integrity and empathy.
2. Each player will respect team members, opposing team, coaches, referees, fans and rink management during games, practices, and travel to and from all activities.
3. Profanity, anger and fighting are prohibited on the ice, on the bench or in the ice facility.
4. Threats will not be tolerated and will be referred to local authorities appropriately.
5. The attending coach is in charge of the bench, shifts, positions, and game strategy. His direction will be followed without dispute.
6. Team activities will be executed by a consensus of players, support staff and coaches.
7. Fees shall be paid in full prior to participation in season play.
8. Player will enroll in 12 credit hours (undergrad) and maintain a 2.0 GPA at UNC Charlotte.
9. Players will report injuries in a timely manner; further play is subject to the coach.

ANNUAL PLAYER AGREEMENT TO PARTICIPATE

I, (name) _____, (Student ID#) ____-____-____, (Major) _____, am aware that participating on an American Collegiate Hockey Association collegiate hockey team involves meeting certain player eligibility requirements.

By my signature below, I acknowledge the following statements and answers are correct:

1. I am enrolled in a program of study considered to be degree seeking according to my school's definition of degree seeking.
2. I am enrolled in a minimum of 9 semester hours as an undergraduate student, or six semester hours as a graduate student.
3. I must complete the minimum requirement of credit hours as outlined in the ACHA Policies and Procedures Manual, Rule IV, D, 2, a to be eligible to play in the following semester.
4. I am allowed 5 years of ACHA eligibility. If, however, I was on an NCAA roster at any time, I am restricted to four years of ACHA Division 3 play, minus the time played at the NCAA level.
5. Any season played for an NCAA, NJCAA, CIAU program shall be considered as a season of eligibility utilized.
6. I have never played the sport of ice hockey professionally at any level.
7. I have never participated in a Tier I, Major Junior A Hockey Program.
8. I am not to receive any financial disbursements, for any reason, directly from the college hockey program, booster club, or hockey program sponsor.
9. I may only receive financial aid which has been properly channeled through the college/university financial aid office or other college/university office. Financial aid shall be awarded on a need basis only as determined by the United States Department of Education Standards for Financial Assistance Program formula as applied to each institution.
